Professor Murray leads clinical brain imaging research in structural and functional brain imaging correlates of cognitive ageing and dementia. She has extensive NHS clinical experience of brain imaging in dementia, with around 400 nuclear medicine brain regional cerebral blood flow SPECT/CT studies per annum and receptor studies in movement disorder. Author of 92 publications, 6 books/book chapters, 1 patent. She is a founding member and current director of the Scottish Imaging Network: A Platform for Scientific Excellence (SINAPSE) www.sinapse.ac.uk a successful brain imaging pooling initiative funded by the Scottish Funding Council and participating universities to develop state of the art imaging research training and resources across Scotland. She is also an executive member of the Scottish Dementia Research Consortium, AKUK Scotland, Generation Scotland and is a recent past President of the Scottish Radiology Society.
